FEE-HELP ELIGIBILITY

The Higher Education Support Act 2003 (HESA) specifies that Higher Education Providers such as the Brisbane College of Theology can only submit applications for FEE-HELP from eligible students. A definition of an eligible student can be found on pages 3 - 4 of the 2008 FEE-HELP information booklet. (The FEE-HELP Information 2008 booklet is available at your member school and with your enrolment pack)

ALL students who have applied for, or will be applying for, FEE-HELP will be required to submit documentary evidence of their Australian Citizenship with their 2008 enrolment form.

Documentary evidence required

For a student born in Australia:

- Certified Australian Birth Certificate.
- In the case of a student who has changed their name eg by marriage, certified documentation which reflects this change must be submitted with their birth certificate.

For a student born overseas:

- A certified copy of their Certificate of Australian Citizenship.
- In the case of a student who has changed their name eg by marriage, certified documentation which reflects this change must be submitted with their Certificate of Australian Citizenship.

Students who are unable to provide the above documentation will be required to pay their fees upfront by the payment due date for the relevant teaching period.
